# Playtime and lunchtime:

At lunchtime, we eat our lunch in the dining hall. We can buy a school lunch, where we have 3 choices - a red tray, a blue tray or a green tray. Primary 1-3

pupils get a free school lunch. Or we can bring a packed lunch from home.

We can bring water or juice, but not fizzy juice to drink with our lunch, and we should bring a bottle of water to drink during the day.

Each term, we have our Westfield Wednesday Walk-in, when families and carers are invited to come in in the morning and do your Soft Start activities with you.

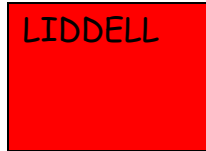
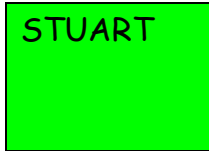


You will probably go on a class trip too - as part of your topic work.
